

RESOLUTION 556-5-12

RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE ASHTABULA COUNTY AUDITOR TO CERTIFY THE TOTAL CURRENT TAX VALUATION OF THE VILLAGE OF ROAMING SHORES, OHIO AND THE DOLLAR AMOUNT OF REVENUE THAT WOULD BE GENERATED BY A RENEWAL LEVY FOR THREE (3) MILLS FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING AND MAINTAINING MOTOR VEHICLES, COMMUNICATIONS, OTHER EQUIPMENT, BUILDINGS, AND SITES FOR SUCH BUILDINGS USED DIRECTLY IN THE OPERATION OF A POLICE DEPARTMENT, OR THE PAYMENT OF SALARIES OF PERMANENT OR PART-TIME POLICE, COMMUNICATIONS, OR ADMINISTRATIVE PERSONNEL TO OPERATE THE SAME, INCLUDING THE PAYMENT OF ANY EMPLOYER CONTRIBUTIONS REQUIRED FOR SUCH PERSONNEL UNDER [SECTION 145.48](#) OR [742.33 OF THE REVISED CODE](#), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY .

WHEREAS, at an election on November 2, 2010 the electors of the Village of Roaming Shores, Ohio approved the renewal of a 3.0 mill levy for the purpose of providing and maintaining motor vehicles, communications, other equipment, buildings, and sites for such buildings used directly in the operation of a police department, or the payment of salaries of permanent or part-time police, communications, or administrative personnel to operate the same, including the payment of any employer contributions required for such personnel under [section 145.48](#) or [742.33 of the Revised Code](#) , the last collection of which will occur in calendar year 2013; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds that it is necessary to renew the existing levy for the purpose of For the purpose of providing and maintaining motor vehicles, communications, other equipment, buildings, and sites for such buildings used directly in the operation of a police department, or the payment of salaries of permanent or part-time police, communications, or administrative personnel to operate the same, including the payment of any employer contributions required for such personnel under [section 145.48](#) or [742.33 of the Revised Code](#), for a period of three years, in excess of the ten-mill limitation; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 5705.03(B) of the Revised Code, in order to submit the question of a tax levy pursuant to Section 5705.19, 5705.191, 5705.25, this Council must request that the Ashtabula County Auditor certify the total current tax valuation of Village of Roaming Shores and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the levy; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 5705.03(B) of the Revised Code, upon receipt of a certified copy of a resolution of this Council declaring the necessity of the tax, stating its purpose, whether it is an additional levy or a renewal or a replacement of an existing tax, and the Section of the Revised Code authorizing its submission to the electors, and requesting such certification, the County Auditor is to certify the total

current tax valuation of the Village of Roaming Shores and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the proposed levy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Roaming Shores, Ashtabula County, Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. This Council finds, determines and declares that it is necessary to renew a 3.0 mill ad valorem property tax outside of the ten-mill limitation for a period of three years, commencing with a levy on the tax list and duplicate for the tax year 2013 to be first distributed to the Village in calendar year 2014 for the purpose of providing and maintaining motor vehicles, communications, other equipment, buildings, and sites for such buildings used directly in the operation of a police department, or the payment of salaries of permanent or part-time police, communications, or administrative personnel to operate the same, including the payment of any employer contributions required for such personnel under [section 145.48](#) or [742.33 of the Revised Code](#) for a period of three years and that it intends to submit the question of the renewal levy to the electors at an election on November 6, 2012 as authorized by Section 5705.19 of the Revised Code.

SECTION 2. This Council requests the Ashtabula County Auditor to certify both (i) the total current tax valuation of the Roaming Shores, and (ii) the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the renewal levy specified in Section 1.

SECTION 3. The Clerk Treasurer of the Village of Roaming Shores is authorized and directed to deliver promptly to the Ashtabula County Auditor a certified copy of this Resolution.

SECTION 4. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken, and that all deliberations of this Board that resulted in those formal actions were held, in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 5. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 6. That this resolution is an emergency and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
