

ORDINANCE 567-10-12

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR/ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A FIVE YEAR CONTRACT WITH WASTE MANAGEMENT FOR EXCLUSIVE RESIDENTIAL TRASH COLLECTION BEGINNING NOVEMBER 1, 2012, A COPY ATTACHED HERETO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Wherefore, the Village has properly advertised for residential trash collection and has determined that Waste Management is the lowest and best bidder,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Roaming Shores, Ohio:

Section 1. The Mayor/Administrator is herein authorized to execute a five year contract with Waste Management for exclusive residential trash pickup beginning November 1, 2012, a copy of which is attached hereto.

Section 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance for the health, safety and welfare of the Village for the reason that the current trash collection contract has already expired; and this ordinance will take effect immediately upon passage.
