

ORDINANCE 583-07-2013

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE OWNER OF EACH LOT ADJOINING LAKE ROAMING SHORES TO PLACE THE STREET ADDRESS OF SUCH LOT ON ANY DOCK OR BOATHOUSE AND NOT DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village Council has determined that it is in the public interest and safety to identify property from the Lake.

WHEREAS, the Village Council has further determined that property can be identified by street addresses located on docks and boat houses.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Roaming Shores, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That each titled owner of a lot adjoining Lake Roaming Shores shall, no later than January 1, 2015, place the street address for such lot on a dock or boathouse if the same is located on such lot.

- a). The lettering for such address shall be no less than five (5) inches tall
- b) Any lot owner who does not have a dock or boathouse on their property shall be exempted from this requirement.
- c) Any person found violating this ordinance shall be guilty of a minor misdemeanor punishable by no more than a \$150.00 fine.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is not an emergency ordinance and shall take effect thirty days after passage.
