

ORDINANCE NO. 562-09-12

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING CHAPTER 5722 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE FOR THE PURPOSE OF FACILITATING THE EFFECTIVE REUTILIZATION OF NONPRODUCTIVE LAND SITUATED WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF ROAMING SHORES, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Section 5722.02 of the Ohio Revised Code authorizes municipal corporations located in Ohio to adopt and implement the procedures set forth in Chapter 5722 of the Ohio Revised Code for the purpose of facilitating the effective reutilization of nonproductive land situated within the corporate limits of the Village of Roaming Shores, Ohio and

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Roaming Shores wishes to adopt, in its entirety, Chapter 5722 of the Ohio Revised Code, specifically including, but not limited to sections 5722.02 to 5722.15, to facilitate the effective reutilization of nonproductive land situated within the Village's boundaries;

WHEREAS, the Village understands and acknowledges that by

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Village of Roaming Shores, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Village of Roaming Shores, Ohio adopts, in its entirety, Chapter 5722 of the Ohio Revised Code, specifically including, but not limited to sections 5722.02 to 5722.15, to facilitate the effective reutilization of nonproductive land situated within the Village of Roaming Shores, Ohio. The existence of nonproductive land within its boundaries is such as to necessitate the implementation of a land reutilization program to foster either the return of such nonproductive land to tax revenue generating status or the devotion thereof to public use.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5: This ordinance is deemed to be an emergency for the health, safety and welfare of the village, and this ordinance shall take effect immediately.
