

ORDINANCE 552-03-12

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE TO DISPOSE OF SURPLUS  
PERSONAL PROPERTY BY INTERNET AUCTION AND DECLARING AN  
EMERGENCY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Roaming Shores, Ohio:

Section 1. That the Village administrator is hereby authorized to sell by internet auction the following Village equipment which is deemed to be surplus property and of no further use to the Village

- 1) 2002 Crown Victoria, #2FAFP71W63X125680  
91,877 miles
- 2) 2001 Crown Victoria, #2FAFP71W62X104603  
168,497 miles

Section 2. The following rules shall apply:

- a) said auction shall be conducted on the following website: [www.govdeals.com](http://www.govdeals.com)
- b) bidding on the property shall be conducted over a period of sixteen calendar (16) days as set forth in the attached terms and conditions.
- c) the Village shall conduct the auction
- d) the minimum price for such property shall be as follows:
  - 1) 2002 Crown Vic #2FAFP71W63X125680 minimum bid \$1,000.00
  - 2) 2001 Crown Vic #2FAFP71W62X104603 minimum bid \$1,000.00
- e) other sale conditions include: see attached terms and conditions.

Section 3. The Clerk Treasurer is directed to publish in a newspaper of general circulation notice of its intent to sell the equipment described above and shall post notices in other conspicuous public places within the village, but only bids submitted through [gov.deals.com](http://gov.deals.com) will be considered.

Section 4. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5. This ordinance is deemed to be an emergency for the health, safety and welfare of the village in order to sell personal property and this ordinance shall take effect immediately.
